Physical Examinations of Students**

Students in grades 5 through 12 must have a physical examination performed prior to participation in extracurricular sports. "Participation," as used in this policy, means participation in sports practices and interscholastic sports competition. The physical examination must be conducted by a physician possessing an unrestricted license to practice medicine, a licensed naturopathic physician, a licensed physician assistant, a certified nurse practitioner or a licensed chiropractic physician who has clinical training and experience in detecting cardiopulmonary diseases and defects.

Students who continue to participate in extracurricular sports in grades 5 through 12 shall be required to complete a physical examination once every two years, thereafter. The physical examination is the responsibility of the parents/students and is to be paid for by parents/students.

Students are required to submit to the district a completed School Sports Pre-participation Examination form¹ prior to their participation. This form shall be kept on file and shall be reviewed by the activities director and coach prior to the start of any sport season in which the student is a participant. Students shall not participate without signed parental and physician permission.

The district shall require a student to have an additional physical examination if he/she is diagnosed with a significant illness or has had major surgery, prior to further participation in extracurricular sports.
