Emergency Procedures and Disaster Plans

The superintendent has the responsibility for coordinating activities with all agencies that are trained to respond in case of an emergency or disaster, such as fire department, police department, Bay Area Hospital, transportation services, telephone, radio and television communications, the National Guard, and others.

The superintendent and the administrators shall be responsible for the implementation of emergency procedures in case of fire or explosion, school bus emergency, severe weather conditions, bomb threat, earthquake, civil disturbance, nuclear threat or disaster, and emergency transportation evacuation. Such procedures will meet or exceed the minimum standards of the State Board of Education and will be made available in all school or unit offices. Parents will be informed of the district's plan for the care of students during an emergency situation.
