

Talented and Gifted – Programs and Services**

A district written plan will be developed for programs and services beyond those normally offered by the regular school program. All required written course statements shall identify the academic instructional programs and services to be provided which accommodate the assessed levels and accelerated rates of learning in identified talented and gifted students. The superintendent will remove any administrative barriers that may exist which restrict a student's access to appropriate services and will develop program and service options. These options may include, but are not limited to, the following:

1. Ungraded/Multi-age Classes;
2. Cluster Grouping in Regular Classes;
3. Continuous Progress;
4. Cross Grade Grouping;
5. Compacted/Fast-Paced Curriculum;
6. Special Full- or Part-Time Classes;
7. Advanced Placement Classes;
8. Honors Classes;
9. Block Classes;
10. Independent Study;
11. Credit by Examination;
12. Concurrent Enrollment;
13. Mentorship/Internship;
14. Academic Competitions;
15. Magnet Programs/Schools.

The Board has established a complaint procedure to utilize if a person who resides in the district or a parent or guardian of a student attending school in the district has a complaint regarding the appropriateness of programs and services provided for the student identified as talented and gifted. This complaint procedure Policy KL - Complaint Procedure for School Patrons, is available at the district's administrative office and on the home page of the district's website.

If a parent or guardian is dissatisfied with the identification process or placement of their student, they may appeal the decision through Board Policy KL - Complaint Procedure for School Patrons. After exhausting the district's appeal procedure and receiving a final decision, a parent may appeal the decision to the State Superintendent of Public Instruction.
