## School Admissions

The district is committed to providing an educational program for all students living in the district. The Board believes all students living in the district who have not completed 12 years of education from ages 5 to 19 (age 21 for special education students) should attend school regularly and be included in the available educational programs.

The district offers kindergarten as an initial school experience. Kindergarten is recommended, but not required. First grade is a required part of each child's schooling and should be successfully completed prior to further advancement.

Students who are otherwise qualified for kindergarten should begin attendance within the first 20 school days in order to be eligible for admission to kindergarten during that school year.

All students new to the district must register at the individual school office. Registration requirements include proof of the student's birth date (a birth certificate, a hospital record or a baptismal record), immunization records as required by law and permission to request previous school records. The district will accept transfer students from other school districts at the same grade level with proof of previous enrollment. Students admitted to any grade must show evidence of completing the prior school year. High school students will be enrolled in the appropriate grade based on their ninth grade enrollment year, a.k.a. cohort year. Student grade level will not be based on credits that students have earned.

Students enrolled in the district shall comply with Oregon laws related to age, residence, health and immunization.

Students located in the district shall not be excluded from admission solely because the student does not have a fixed place of residence or solely because the student is not under the supervision of a parent/guardian or person in parental relationship.

The district may admit an otherwise eligible person who is not receiving special education and who has not yet attained 21 years of age prior to the beginning of the current school year if the person is shown to be in need of additional education in order to secure a diploma.
