Emergency Procedures and Disaster Plans

The superintendent will develop and maintain a plan specifying procedures to be used in such emergencies as animal(s) loose in the building, disorderly behavior, unlawful assembly, disturbances at school activities, natural disasters, fire, illness or injury of a student or staff member, and use of force on school property. The superintendent will consult with community and county agencies while developing this plan.

The emergency procedures plan of the district will meet or exceed the minimum standards of the State Board of Education.

Copies of the emergency procedures plan will be available in every school office and other unit offices. Parents will be informed of the district's plan for the care of students during an emergency situation.

In the event of such closures, since parents/guardian may not be at home, it shall be the policy of the district to retain students and staff at the school buildings in case of extreme emergency when less than one hour of warning time is known. Parents/Guardians may come to the school premises to pick up their children if parents/guardians so desire.
