Temporary District Facilities

Because rented facilities, relocatable units and other emergency school housing are almost invariably inadequate for public school purposes, it is the aim of the Board to have sufficient permanent facilities to meet the needs of school enrollment and the school program.

If circumstances require immediate space which is not available in public school buildings, facilities will be rented and/or relocatable structures will be used only as a temporary measure.

The Board encourages the involvement of staff, parents and the patrons in the decision making process whenever possible. The superintendent will give due consideration to all such input in his/her recommendations to the Board. All final decisions regarding the use of temporary district facilities will be made by the Board.

Any such facility must conform to all appropriate federal, state and local building and land use codes, health and fire laws, environmental standards and provisions for accessibility and usability as required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
