Home Schooling**

The Board recognizes the rights of parents to teach their students at home.

Further, the Board is willing to assist parents in this endeavor if a request is made through the superintendent. The Board will furnish basic course descriptions, state standards for elementary and secondary education, and, when available, may furnish basic instructional materials upon deposit of a loss/damage fee.

Students may, upon parent request, be allowed to participate in district programs such as physical education programs, instrumental and vocal music programs, or other selected options if space and materials are available. Such students must then adhere to regular attendance procedures as established by the school and must avoid disruption of said programs.

Parents are responsible for transportation for students attending selected school offerings.

The Board reaffirms its prerogative to accept or not to accept home instruction course credit toward graduation requirements.
