Class Size

The Board resolves to make every effort to maintain the following class size guidelines. The Board directs that any K-6 class size or secondary teacher/student ratio that exceeds the limits will be brought to the Board for review no later than the next meeting.

An average class size policy is established to provide for an adequate teacher/student ratio. The following ratios are established as goals for average class sizes:

1. Grades K-3 should not exceed an average of 25 students per teacher for a single grade assignment;
2. Grades 4-6 should not exceed an average of 30 students per teacher for a single grade assignment;
3. Class size average for a two-grade assignment may not exceed 25.

Secondary

1. Teachers may have six periods of instruction in a seven period day. Teachers may average 160 student-hours per day except in the academic areas of keyboarding, music and physical education.
