

Student Motorized Vehicle Use

The following conditions govern the use of all motor-driven vehicles - this includes automobiles, motorcycles, motor bikes, motor scooters, etc. operated by students to and/or from school.

A written request is to be furnished the principal by a parent or guardian. Such request must include:

1. The reason for the student to drive to school;
2. The name and license number of the driver;
3. Passengers, if any;
4. Vehicle description - manufacturer, model, style, color and license number of vehicle. (If more than one, describe others.)

This information should be furnished to the building principal before the vehicle is operated by the student. Following vehicular registration the student will be issued a vehicle use/park pass.

The principal's approval of the driving request should not in any way be interpreted as an extension of the school district's insurance.

Vehicle Use Rules

1. Students bringing cars (or other motor-driven vehicles) to school are not to use them during the school day unless permission is given by the principal.
2. Students are not to sit or eat in the cars while classes are in session.
3. All students are to leave the cars parked from the time they arrive in the morning until they leave in the evenings. This includes after-school activities.
4. All student vehicles are to be parked in designated areas in an orderly manner because of space limitation and traffic patterns.
5. The maximum speed for vehicles on the school grounds is 10 m.p.h.
6. School busses must be given priority on the school grounds.

Violations of the rules shall result in forfeiture of privileges as determined by the principal.
