Corvallis School District graduates will be:

1. Knowledgeable
 - a. Demonstrate essential skills and knowledge in language: listening, speaking, reading, and writing;
 - b. Demonstrate essential skills and knowledge in mathematics;
 - c. Demonstrate knowledge of the geographies, histories, and cultures of the community, region, nation, and world;
 - d. Demonstrate knowledge and skills in the basic principles, concepts, and language of the social sciences;
 - e. Demonstrate knowledge and skills in the basic principles, concepts, and language of the natural sciences;
 - f. Demonstrate knowledge and skills in the basic principles, concepts, and language of the arts;
 - g. Demonstrate essential skills and knowledge in human movement, health, and fitness.
2. Capable Thinkers
 - a. Use a variety of thinking processes to identify problems, make decisions, and resolve complex issues;
 - b. Gather, evaluate, and use information from a variety of sources;
 - c. Apply the strategies, techniques, and processes of the sciences, humanities, and arts;
 - d. Apply concepts of natural, social, and organizational systems.
3. Effective Communicators
 - a. Communicate through listening, speaking, reading, and writing and through visual and symbolic forms;
 - b. Communicate effectively with diverse audiences;
 - c. Communicate in at least one other language;
 - d. Interpret human experience through literature and the arts;
 - e. Use technology as a communication tool;
 - f. Demonstrate effective interpersonal skills.

4. Responsible Citizens
 - a. Demonstrate responsibility as an individual and as a community member;
 - b. Recognize and propose thoughtful solutions to local, national, and world problems;
 - c. Demonstrate consideration for individual differences and for the contribution of diversity to society;
 - d. Display positive health behaviors.

5. Self-directed Learners
 - a. Create a positive vision for themselves and for their future;
 - b. Set priorities and goals; construct and execute a plan for achieving those goals;
 - c. Create options for themselves;
 - d. Evaluate and manage their own progress toward goals;
 - e. Demonstrate skills to get and keep a job.

6. Collaborative Workers
 - a. Participate as a member of a team and assume appropriate roles: lead, follow, and support others in a productive manner;
 - b. Collaborate toward achieving a common goal;
 - c. Resolve conflict effectively.

7. Quality Producers
 - a. Create products that achieve their purpose for the intended audience;
 - b. Use craftsmanship, originality, and appropriate technology to produce high quality products.
