

Policy Implementation

The superintendent is responsible for implementing Board policies and for interpreting them to staff, students, and the public. Other administrators share in this responsibility.

Some board policies require implementing an administrative regulation. Whenever appropriate, the superintendent will develop these administrative regulations, in consultation with principals, staff members, and other persons and groups and the superintendent will submit them to the Board for review or approval as appropriate.

Policies officially adopted by the Board and other administrative regulations formulated to implement adopted Board policies will be included in the Board policy manual located on the district's website. Staff, student, and parent handbooks also will be used for disseminating policies and regulations to persons directly affected by them. Each employee will be specifically notified of the existence and availability of personnel policies.

Principals are authorized to establish rules and procedures for the staff and student bodies of their schools as long as these rules and procedures are consistent with policies and regulations established by the Board and superintendent.
