

## Traffic and Parking Controls

The superintendent, through support services managers, shall authorize parking areas and post notices on district property designated for staff, student, visitor parking and parking for persons with disabilities and other classifications of parking areas as may be necessary.

Any vehicle not parked in authorized areas may be towed away and stored. All charges for towing and storing will be the responsibility of the owner or operator of the vehicle.

Unauthorized overnight parking on district property is prohibited. Additionally, the parking of a vehicle on district property for the sole purpose of advertising or sale of said vehicle is also prohibited. Violators are subject to towing at owner's expense.

Any person failing to abide by the district's parking regulations may be further prohibited from bringing any vehicle on school property. In addition, staff or students who fail to abide by the district's parking regulations may be subject to further discipline.

Support services, in cooperation with building principals or other appropriate building staff, will establish regulations as necessary for the use and control of visitor, staff and student parking areas, as well as use of bus loading/unloading areas and parking designated for persons with disabilities, around their buildings. Such regulations will be made available to staff, students and parents.
