Research

Employees will be encouraged to participate in research and experimentation in the interests of the development and improvement of education. If an employee plans to engage in a research project, either for study toward advanced work or for use in classroom instruction, details should be made known to the building principal. If such a study results in material which would be useful to other employees, it is recommended that it be made available to distribution throughout the district. For the protection of all concerned, students or other individuals involved in research projects must be kept anonymous.

All research which is conducted by or for a nondistrict employee must be cleared through the superintendent or designee.
