

Alternative Graduation Requirements

1. Modified Diploma Requirements

A student's school team may decide that a student should work toward a modified diploma, no earlier than the end of sixth grade and no later than two years before the student's exit from high school. The team members must include a parent or guardian of the student and others appropriate for the student's review, including teachers, counselors, and building administrators or their representatives. In the case of a student receiving special education, the team may be made up of IEP team members. In the case of a student receiving services at a public charter school, the resident school district shall determine the team.

2. Procedures for Alternative Diploma Options

- a. A parent, IEP team, or student care team may convene a meeting to discuss a student's need for a modified diploma or an alternative certificate of completion.
- b. If the team feels a modified diploma or alternative certificate of completion is appropriate, a consent form for the selected alternative is filled out and signed. If the student is in high school, the modified diploma planning sheet will be developed.
- c. The modified diploma paperwork will be kept in the student's cumulative file and reviewed annually.
