School Boundary Areas

Attendance areas are established by the administration and approved by the Board. Attendance boundaries are created in the district to ensure an equitable and appropriate distribution of students at all district schools.

The purpose of a defined and enforced boundary attendance policy is to reduce the potential of overcrowding or under enrollment.

The superintendent is directed to monitor student flow into and out of all buildings, and to make adjustments to boundary areas as needed with Board approval. All changes in school attendance areas should benefit the total school program educationally and financially.
