School Choice Program **

The Board recognizes that the educational goals of the district can best be attained through educational programs as diverse as students' needs within a pluralistic society. Therefore, the Board encourages the development of a variety of school options through the cooperative efforts of educators, parents, students, and/or community resources.

Corvallis schools offer a variety of instructional programs. Parents may choose to enroll their student in their own neighborhood school, a school in another neighborhood, or school with a specialized curriculum.

1. Neighborhood schools have defined geographic boundaries and develop programs that reflect the needs and interests of their families.
2. Specialized schools offer a distinctive curriculum or instructional approach that may be school wide or a program within the school. There may or may not be a neighborhood boundary for these schools.
