

Early Entrance**

Upon request for early admission to kindergarten or first grade, the following guidelines will be used:

1. A request for early admission to kindergarten or first grade will be made by parents to the superintendent, in writing;
2. Receipt of such a request will activate an ad hoc committee to discuss the possibility of early entry. Members of the committee may include kindergarten teachers, first grade teachers, an administrator and others deemed appropriate by the superintendent;
3. The parents or guardians will be made aware that testing and analysis of testing by a qualified agency, approved by the superintendent, shall be at the expense of the parents;
4. The early entrance committee will review all information and parent interviews. If a student is to be considered for early entrance, the student will also undergo a one day screening/observation;
5. The screening committee will make recommendations to the superintendent based on the steps outlined above. Parents will be notified in writing of the superintendent's decision;
6. Written appeal can be made by parents or guardians to the superintendent. If the respective decision does not meet the approval of the parents, a subsequent hearing may be held with the Board.
