Student Conduct

The Board expects student conduct to contribute to a productive learning climate. Students shall comply with the district's written rules, pursue the prescribed course of study, submit to the lawful authority of district staff and conduct themselves in an orderly manner at school during the school day or during school-sponsored activities.

Careful attention shall be given to procedures and methods whereby fairness and consistency in discipline shall be assured each student. The objectives of disciplining any student must be to help a student develop self-discipline, realize the responsibility of one's actions and maintain a productive learning climate. All staff members have responsibility for consistency in establishing and maintaining an appropriate learning climate.

A student code of conduct, developed under the leadership of the district, and in cooperation with staff, will be made available to parents and students in the school handbook. That code of conduct will be rigidly enforced in the school. Additionally, students may be denied participation in extracurricular activities. Titles and/or privileges granted to students may also be revoked (e.g., valedictorian, salutatorian, student body, class or club office positions, senior trip, prom, etc.). A referral to law enforcement may also be made.
