Public Solicitation in District Facilities

Students and staff are to be protected from intrusions by announcements, posters, bulletins and communications of any kind from individuals and organizations not directly connected with the schools.

The solicitation and sale of travel services to students is prohibited on school property, at activities under the jurisdiction of the district and at interscholastic activities administered by a voluntary organization approved by the State Board of Education (i.e., Oregon School Activities Association).

This includes sale of services to students by any person or group that sells, provides, furnishes, contracts for, arranges or advertises travel services.

The administration of surveys, questionnaires and requests for information by non-school-connected organizations may be disallowed at the discretion of the superintendent.

The district will not participate in any fund-raising drive which is not consistent with Board policy.

Advertising may be permitted at the discretion of the superintendent.
