Dallas Education Fund

Dallas Education Fund was established as a restricted fund in the Dallas Community Foundation, an Oregon nonprofit corporation, to meet the educational needs of students in Dallas School District. The Board of Directors in Dallas School District is responsible for developing policy and procedures for the distributions of the funds and for requesting funds from the Dallas Community Foundation.

Annually, the Board of Directors will appoint an advisory committee comprised of not less than 10 community members to develop recommendations to the Board of Directors. The committee's purpose will be as follows:

1. To make general and policy recommendations to the Dallas School Board regarding management and expenditures of the Dallas Education Fund.
2. To review and provide specific recommendations to the Dallas School Board on individual proposals for expenditures of the Dallas Education Fund.
3. To develop and implement methods for increasing the resource base of the Dallas Education Fund.

Upon recommendations from the Advisory Committee, the Board of Directors will annually request disbursement from the Foundation for projects that meet the educational needs of students. In addition, the Board of Directors may request disbursement when contributions were given for a specific project or purpose. Quarterly, the Board of Directors may seek reimbursement from the foundation for administrative expenses related to fund raising efforts to build the Dallas Education Fund.
