Employment of Licensed Educators

As required by law, each teacher or specialist employed by Dallas School District shall obtain the proper license with the appropriate endorsement from the Oregon Teacher Standards and Practices Commission to qualify in the position for which employed.

Licenses shall be submitted to the Superintendent's Office for registration prior to the first day of the school year or give evidence that all requirements have been met and documents filed with the Oregon Teacher Standards and Practices Commission for proper licensure. If a teacher or specialist does not meet either of these two (2) conditions, that person shall not begin performance of the contract and shall not receive salary for time lost.

A teacher or specialist, who is required by law to hold a license and does not, shall not be paid for work performed in such a position.

Obtaining and submitting for registration, in a timely manner, a proper license with the appropriate endorsement is the sole responsibility of the teacher or specialist. Failure to obtain and to submit for registration a proper license with the appropriate endorsement within the legally prescribed time limits shall be cause for immediate suspension or dismissal from employment.
