Exchange Teaching

The Board supports the concept of exchange teaching as a means to provide professional growth opportunities for teachers. The district also supports the exchange teaching program as an opportunity for cultural experiences but not as a forum to advocate a cultural difference. The superintendent shall develop procedures by which teachers may participate in exchange teaching programs.

The district shall limit the number of teaching exchanges.

Visiting exchange teachers shall be selected when the district considers the choice to be a good match for the district.

The superintendent shall develop procedures by which teachers may participate in exchange teaching programs. Procedures for visiting exchange teachers shall include orientation, additional in-service, clarification of assignment, as well as monitoring and supervising.

The superintendent will address the following in the processing of the exchange teacher application: professional qualifications, retirement, license, fringe benefits, salary placement, experience, length of service, PERS, sick leave accumulation and other relevant factors.

The Board expects teachers to return to the district and teach for a minimum of three years following the exchange teaching.
