Home Schooling/Private Schooling Instruction

The School Board affirms the rights of parents/legal guardians to use home instruction and/or private school as an alternative to school enrollment.

Further, the School Board is willing to assist parents/legal guardians in this endeavor if a request is made through the Superintendent or designee. The School Board will furnish basic course descriptions, and state minimum textbooks, if available, with deposit of a loss/damage fee.

The School Board recognizes the potential for some students to benefit from the formal school program as well as from home instruction or private schooling. Opportunity for partial enrollment will be extended to any Polk County student who wishes to attend the Dallas School District.

Only courses recognized by the State of Oregon will earn credits toward a diploma. The School Board reaffirms its prerogative not to accept home instruction course credit toward graduation requirements.

Policies regarding the provision of Special Education and related services are covered under Policy IGBAL; Special Education - Services for Home Schooled Students With Disabilities and Policy IGBAI; Special Education, Private Schools.
