Instructional Program

All curriculum adopted by Dallas School District shall be developed and implemented consistent with the requirements of Oregon Administrative Rules Oregon Revised Statutes, Dallas School District's Philosophy of Education, the District's Mission and Goals for Learners, and the Strategic Plan.

Curriculum development shall reflect the professional expertise of administrators, teachers, and support specialists at all age/grade levels. Parents/legal guardians and patron input and involvement in curriculum development may be sought as appropriate.

Building site councils and the District School Improvement Council are established to provide for a systematic and consistent review and evaluation of curriculum development. All committees or groups organized under this policy shall be advisory to the Superintendent and the School Board. Reports, recommendations, or proposals prepared by such committees or groups are subject to School Board acceptance, rejection, or modification.

The School Board delegates and assigns the management of the approved instructional program process to the Superintendent, District administrators and building administrators. Administrators are directed to provide leadership, direction and supervision for the instructional program to assure implementation by all teachers and other staff sharing this responsibility.

Teachers, specialists and other staff are directed to implement the approved curricula, to use the approved guides and instructional materials, and to maintain a management system which provides adequate records of student achievement and growth.

Parents/legal guardians shall be notified in advance and shall have the opportunity to excuse their son/daughter from curriculum areas dealing with sex education and/or Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS).
