Alternative Education Programs

Notification of Students, Parents/Legal Guardians

Notification to a student, parent/legal guardian shall include, but not be limited to:

1. student action which is the basis for consideration of alternative education;
2. listing of alternative programs available for this student for which the District would provide financial support;
3. the program recommended for the student based on student's learning styles and needs;
4. procedures for enrolling the student in the recommended program.

Notification regarding alternative education programs can also be located in the student/parent handbook of each school as well as the Special Education Handbook.

Current Alternative Credit Programs that May Be Available to Students Include:

1. High school completion program through Chemeketa Community College
2. G.E.D. Options program through Chemeketa Community College
3. Tutorial instruction through the Special Education Department of Dallas School District
4. Correspondence courses through the Special Education Department of Dallas School District
5. Polk Adolescent Day Treatment Center
6. Dallas High Teen Parent Program
7. By Design
8. Students on Academic Recovery (SOAR)

Request for Enrollment in Alternative Education Programs

Enrollment request can be processed through each school or by contacting the superintendent.

Alternative education programs will be evaluated annually for the following criteria:

1. All criminal records check requirements met. Provide list of individuals subject to criminal records checks and copy of Form 2283 from the Oregon Department of Education;
2. Instruction in the state content standards to prepare students to meet appropriate benchmark levels to provide an opportunity to receive the CIM/CAM with supportive documentation;
3. Administer and report results of Oregon Statewide Assessments;
4. Documentation indicating that the program complies with nondiscrimination requirements
5. Registered with the Oregon Department of Education;
6. Complies with health and safety statutes and rules;
7. Complies with Oregon Revised Statutes on tuition and fees (ORS 337.150, 339.141, 339.147, 339.155);
8. Contract on file with District and program, as applicable;
9. Additional requirements as directed by the Superintendent.
