On-Campus Dual Credit

The School Board authorizes the establishment of On-Campus Dual Credit classes for students regularly enrolled in Dallas High School.

On-Campus Dual Credit means that a student may earn credit at the high school level and also at the college level in a class specifically established for that purpose and when he/she meets all applicable requirements and standards of the class and/or subsequent tests.

Implementation procedures including classes to be offered, post high school programs or institutions with whom to be associated, participation standards and procedures, and approval procedures shall be developed in accordance with the District's curriculum development process. Since students enrolled in the On-Campus Dual Credit class shall benefit from earned college credit while still enrolled in high school, any tuition, textbook, or other costs related to the acquiring of post high school credit shall be the responsibility of the individual student. The District will provide District adopted textbooks if these texts are also acceptable to the cooperating college or university.
