

On-Campus Dual Credit

Guideline governing student enrollment in On-Campus Dual Credit courses.

Implementation Procedures

1. Programs approved under the provision of this policy must be associated with an accredited Oregon College or University.
2. The dual credit course must be approved by the School Improvement Council and recognized by the School Board.

Participation

1. Each student will be counseled before registering for class to be sure that the student will benefit from the instruction.
2. The building principal or designee will make students and parents/legal guardians aware of any financial expectations beyond District support.

Textbooks and Supplies

1. Where practicable, the District adopted text and the college approved text shall be the same.
2. Costs of texts not District adopted shall be at the student's personal expense.
3. Supplies required for work that is not an expectation of the high school class shall be at the student's personal expense.

Curriculum

Unless a course is specifically identified as a dual credit class with the total enrollment of students participating in the program, the curriculum to be used by the teacher will be the District adopted curriculum.
