## School Activities Programs

The scope or type and number of school sponsored activities will be planned, organized and supervised in keeping with accepted practice based on recent growth and development studies.

In grades K through 5, most activities will be a direct result and an extension of classroom procedures and developments. There will be no competitive cocurricular programs in grades K -3. In grades 4-5, limited programs of athletics may be provided.

In grades 6-8, a broad and varied program of student government, clubs, music, athletics, drama, etc., will be offered to challenge the special interests and abilities of large numbers of students.

The program of activities in grades 9 through 12 will be the most broad, varied, and demanding in regard to time, supervision, and cost, and will also require decision, choices and perhaps sacrifice on the part of student participants.

Periodic evaluations of activities at all levels will be made in terms of student need, cost, participation, facilities and available and capable supervisors.
