

Course Requirement Alternatives

Approval to grant credit alternatives for state and District required programs shall be based upon the following:

1. A written statement from the student and the student's parent/legal guardian of the anticipated educational advantages which will result from the alternative.
2. An evaluation and recommendation of the request by the high school principal or his/her designee and a high school counselor.
3. The high school principal or his/her designee shall present the request to the superintendent for action at a regularly scheduled school board meeting.
4. Upon completion of the alternative, credit shall be granted to the student.

The building principal may arrange with the parents/legal guardians to excuse a student for instruction on an individual basis during the time when the classroom teacher and the principal agree that the student's educational development would not be adversely affected. Such arrangement shall not exceed a total time from the classroom of one (1) hour per week. It may be terminated by the principal if it is determined that the student's school work is suffering or that distractions or disruptions are occurring in the classroom as a result of these arrangements.

The arrangement for excusing a student is to be in writing and signed by the parent/legal guardian and the principal. Such arrangement is to be limited to one (1) school year and may be renewed.
