## Board Legal Status

The district, a common school district providing education for grades K-12 has as its governing body, a Board of Directors. The legal basis for education is vested in the will of the people as expressed in the Constitution of the state of Oregon, the statutes pertaining to education, court interpretation of these laws and powers implied under them. The Board formulates its own policies, as a policy making body, for the governing of the schools, consistent with the State Board of Education.

Board members shall be elected biennially in May of each odd-numbered year. Regularly elected members shall serve for a period of four years. The term of office for members appointed to fill a vacancy will be until June 30 following the next regular district election. The regular terms of office shall begin on the first day of July following the election.

The Board shall be composed of seven members, elected in accordance with Oregon statutes.
