Buildings and Grounds Inspection

A formal safety inspection of buildings and grounds is to be done once each month and at other times as needed throughout the year by the district safety officer. One copy of the inspection report is to be filed at the site and one copy is to be sent to the superintendent. Particular attention should be given to the following:

1. That approved safety devices are installed and ready for use;
2. That emergency measures are defined and posted;
3. That warning notices are posted where needed.
