School Bus Scheduling and Routing

The district includes a large area of rural territory. Because of the distances involved, the district has established bus routes and a bus transportation system for the convenience of individuals living at a distance from the schools.

The geography of the district, weather factors and the type and conditions of the road in this district combine to present special hazards throughout much of the normal school year. These factors require that special precautions, including assurance that the drivers' attention is not distracted from the road, be taken in the transportation of our most valuable assets, the children of the district.

All students living along established bus routes in the rural areas are entitled to school bus transportation to and from school in a safe manner for the regular school session, provided they follow the established behavior guidelines. However, due to the heavy demands made upon the school bus transportation system and the limits of both facilities and finances, the district will not provide nor pay for transportation of students who live less than one mile from the established bus routes. Students living less than one mile from the established main bus routes but living more than one mile from school may board the bus at the loading point designated by the school authorities.

It will be the responsibility of the individual student or parent to transport to this point.
