## Special Use of School Buses

All children attending any private or parochial school under the compulsory school attendance laws will, where the private or parochial school is along or near the bus route, be provided equally the riding privileges given to public school children.

It is the primary purpose of the district to provide home to school transportation. All athletic, activity, or field trips shall have secondary priorities when they conflict with the availability of such transportation. The district shall provide transportation to only those activities directly involving district-approved programs.

Recognizing that total student participation in the various activities, either as participants or as spectators, contributes to the total effectiveness of any school, the board approves of making spectator buses available when deemed desirable by the school administrator, provided requests have been made under district regulations. A transportation fee may be charged for this type of transportation to recover up to actual cost of the trip.

Spectators may not ride on the bus that carries the participants to and from the activity, unless directly approved by the building administrator.
