Cocurricular and Extracurricular Programs

Student activities shall be regarded as a vital part of the educational program and shall be used as a means of developing wholesome attitudes, good human relations, as well as increasing knowledge and skills.

The building administrator shall be responsible for the organization of all student activities. He/She shall provide adequate supervision, administer student finances and approve all student activities with the assistance of members of the faculty delegated by the principal as advisors.

A parent or guardian may request that a student be excused from certain types of student activities for religious or physical reasons.

Upon registration at Dayton High School each student becomes a member thereof, and as such is eligible to participate in the non-associated Student Body activities.
