Student Performances

It shall be the policy of the district to provide opportunities for public performances of students in those areas where performances are an out-growth of a classroom learning situation or an accepted school-sponsored activity program. Care should be exercised to protect the pupils from excessive demands on their time which might adversely affect their school work.

Instructors are encouraged to arrange for individual students and groups to provide public performances when such performances contribute to educational process objectives and when they do not interfere with other scheduled activities or classes within the school, as follows:

1. All performances involving students will be approved by the principal;
2. The extended use of one particular group will be discouraged;
3. Students participating in a performance will conduct themselves in a way as to bring credit to their school.

Student groups may participate in the activities of the district and with groups in the community upon the approval of the principal. They will not be paid for participating or performing when they represent the school.
