Use of Feature Films/Videos**

The Board recognizes the showing of commercially produced and rated feature films and videos may have a legitimate purpose in a school's educational program. However, since the content of these feature films customarily is designed for general audience viewing, the Board feels certain precautions should be taken to ensure the showing of a particular film is consistent with the educational values espoused by the district. Only films rated G, PG or PG-13 may be shown as part of the school program. The Board directs administrative regulations to be developed to accomplish this objective, including the provision that a parent have the opportunity to preview a film when practicably possible and that a parent must give prior consent before his/her student may view a film rated PG or PG-13.

Should a film rated R have unique educational merit or impact which would warrant its showing in a school's educational program, the superintendent may establish guidelines whereby selected portions of the film may be shown to students.
