Credit for Proficiency

The district may grant credit toward graduation to students whose work experience, prior or alternative education or community service program provides sufficient evidence of proficiency in a particular subject area. Before granting credit, the district may require a student to pass a competency or skills assessment, to provide samples of work or other documentation/evidence of learning, or to complete any combination of the above to satisfaction of the superintendent that demonstrates a level of knowledge that meets or exceeds district academic standards. The Board directs the superintendent to develop an administrative regulation that establishes criteria for granting proficiency credit. Any request for credit shall meet the credit requirements as outline by ODE.
