Campus Policy**

Open campus will be considered for students meeting the following criteria:

1. 11th and 12th grades, with students in grade 12 having the option of open campus each day school is in session and students in grade 11 having open campus only on Wednesday.
2. Students who are in grade Kindergarten through 10th may not have open campus.
3. Students who leave school grounds without authorized permission are considered truant.

Rules for Open Campus

1. Open campus hours are during high school lunch time only.
2. Students must have permission slips signed by parent or guardian on file in the office.
3. Students must check out and in each day they choose to leave for open campus. Failure to do this will result in loss of open campus privileges.
4. Students may not use vehicles during open campus.
5. Students may not enter their own home or anyone else's home without specific administrative permission.
6. Students must be in class after lunch. One tardy is a warning, second tardy will result in the student relinquishing his/her open campus privilege for the rest of the semester.
7. Students must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 and failing no classes.
8. If the student is considered "ineligible" because of failing grades, open campus privileges will be on hold until the student becomes eligible again.
9. The GPA will be assessed at the end of each grading period to determine open campus eligibility.

All students participating in open campus privileges will continue to be under all district policies and student handbook policies while off campus.
