

Disposal of District Property

The Board recognizes that some district property may need to be declared as surplus and authorizes the Superintendent or his designee to determine its disposal when such property is no longer useful to the district, unsuitable for use, too costly to repair or obsolete. This policy does not relate to real property as all real property must be declared surplus by the Board.

The Superintendent will designate administrative regulations to provide for the declaration and disposal of surplus personal property.

If the district property was purchased with state, federal or private grant funds disposal of the property shall be made as outlined in the grant or by state or federal regulations.
