

## **Title I/Title III Parent Involvement**

The Board recognizes that parent involvement is vital to achieve maximum educational growth for students participating in the district's Title programs. Therefore, in compliance with federal law and Oregon Department of Education guidelines, these programs will be planned and operated in meaningful consultation with parents of participating students.

Each of the district's schools participating in the Title I or Title III programs will meet annually with parents. Parents of participating students shall be informed of their right to be involved in the development of the district's parental involvement procedures, overall Title I plan and school-parent compacts.

The district shall provide access for participation of parents with limited English proficiency, parents with disabilities, parents of homeless students and parents of migratory students. Information and school reports will be provided in an understandable and uniform format and, to the extent practicable, in a language parents can understand.

Procedures as necessary to implement this policy and meet the requirements of law will be maintained in either handbook form and/or accessible electronically on the district's website.

### **Policy Assuring Comparability of Materials and Supplies**

In compliance with the requirements of P.L. 97-35, Section 558(2)(B) of Chapter I, Title V, the Board directs the superintendent to ensure equivalence among schools in teachers, administration and other staff and in the provision of curriculum materials and instructional supplies.
