Board Member Removal from Office

The Board shall declare the office of a director vacant upon any of the following:

1. When an incumbent dies or resigns;
2. When an incumbent is removed from office or the election thereto has been declared void by the judgment of decree of any competent court;
3. When an incumbent ceases to be a resident of a school district that is a component school district of the ESD;
4. When an incumbent ceases to be a resident of the zone from which nominated;
5. When an incumbent ceases to discharge the duties of the office for two consecutive months unless prevented there from by sickness or other unavoidable cause; or
6. When an incumbent is recalled;
7. A director nominated from a zone who changes a permanent residence from one zone to another zone in which another director resides shall continue to serve as director for the remainder of the unexpired term;
8. A director guilty of misfeasance or malfeasance in office, by the appropriate proceeding, may be removed from office by a court of competent jurisdiction;
9. Members may be recalled in the manner provided for recall of directors of school district boards.

The ESD board may not declare the office of a director vacant if the director is a resident of a school district that withdraws from the ESD, unless:

1. The director's term expires; or
2. The education service district board declares the office vacant for a reason described in 1 through 9 above.
