## Advisory Committees to the Board

1. Advisory Committees Requested by Component Districts
  - a. If two or more component districts adopt resolutions petitioning the Board to establish a local advisory committee, the Board shall establish such a committee to advise it on matters of concern.
  - b. The Board chair and superintendent shall meet with the Board chairs and superintendents of the component districts passing the resolution to determine the purpose and duties of the local advisory committee, the duration of the committee, its composition and number of members, their terms of office, the manner of appointment and a systematic means of communication between the advisory committee and the Board.
  
2. Advisory Committees Requested by the Board
  - a. The Board, upon its own motion, may appoint advisory committees to advise it on the issues of importance.
  - b. In electing to form an advisory committee, the Board shall determine the purpose and duties of the committee, its duration, its composition and number of members, their terms of office, the manner of appointment and a systematic means of communication between the advisory committee and the Board.
