Grant Proposals and Applications

The primary mission of the DESD is to assist and support the education of all students within its boundaries. To this end, the DESD will pursue all financial resources outside of tax revenue.

Grants-in-aid may become available from private entities, or from the federal or state government. The DESD will pursue those grants that will assist it in meeting its educational goals and objectives or that will create facilities, purchase equipment or otherwise assist in sustaining necessary programs.

The Board directs that each presentation regarding the pursuit of outside funding include the obligations, expectations or encumbrances which will exist when the grant or other outside funding ceases, and how the grant relates to the mission of Douglas ESD.

The Board will consider the above criteria as it acts upon requests to pursue grants, will expect a recommendation from the superintendent and a full explanation of all aspects of the proposal before approving any application.

The Board reaffirms its veto power over all grants prior to actual acceptance of funds.
