Driver Responsibilities in DESD Vehicles

In addition to adherence to Douglas Education Service District (DESD) policy regarding student transportation, drivers who transport DESD students shall:

1. Operate the vehicle at all times in a safe and responsible manner.
2. Comply with all state and federal law and regulations governing the transportation of school age children.
3. Maintain order in the vehicle but refrain from the use of corporal punishment.
4. Report all violations of the DESD Student Conduct Code or applicable DESD administrative regulations to the program supervisor or superintendent.
5. Report all accidents involving the vehicle or DESD students to the program supervisor or superintendent as soon as practicable after the incident.

Vehicle drivers will be responsible for the vehicle at all times from departure until return. The driver will not participate in any activities that might impair his/her driving abilities.

DESD will comply with all state and federal laws and regulations pertaining to transportation of school age children and children with disabilities.
