

Student Discipline

Violent Misconduct

Any ESD student who engages in any violent behavior will be subject to the following:

1. Criminal or juvenile action if the violation is such that it warrants a referral to the appropriate agency;
2. Ejection from and/or banishment from an ESD facility or program or the area where a ESD-related activity is being conducted;
3. Disciplinary action up to and including expulsion from an ESD program.

Procedures for Violent Offenses

1. If the reported incident involves any of the violations listed above, the infraction will be immediately referred to the superintendent.
2. The consequence should be commensurate with the degree of the violation and the history of misbehavior.
3. In cases not involving firearms or deadly weapons, the superintendent shall impose sanctions up to 10 days suspension.
4. In cases involving an actual and credible risk of injury or which are otherwise aggravated or recurring, the staff may refer for expulsion.

Illegal items or other possessions reasonably determined by ESD to be a threat to the safety or security of the possessor or others may be seized by ESD staff in accordance with the prescribed property confiscation procedures. Items, which may be used to disrupt or interfere with the educational process, shall be temporarily removed from the student's possession.
