## Student Health Services and Requirements

It is the policy of the ESD to protect the health and safety of all students served by ESD programs.

At a minimum, the ESD shall:

1. Provide a space at all ESD facilities that is appropriately equipped for providing first aid to ESD students and isolates a sick or injured child from other students participating in ESD programs;
2. Provides for communicable disease control and blood borne pathogen control, as well as the admission of students with HIV/AIDS to ESD programs;
3. Provides health screening information regarding immunization and coordination with community health care and social service agencies;
4. Provides services for students who are medically fragile or have special health care needs;
5. Provides for self administration of medications;
6. Provides for the administration of noninjectable medications;
7. Provides for appropriate and secure storage and dissemination of ESD student medical records and information.
