Supervision of Students**

The ESD shall provide a safe and supportive learning environment for all students receiving ESD services. To accomplish this goal, all ESD staff providing direct services to students shall inform the students of the provisions of the ESD Student Conduct Code and all other applicable ESD Policies applicable to student behavior.

ESD staff may establish specific rules or guidelines for the various ESD programs or activities. These rules or guidelines must be consistent with and supplement Board policy and approved ESD administrative regulations. Prior to the start of each school year, staff will provide the superintendent with a copy of the specific program or activity rules.

ESD staff providing ESD services at a component district's facility must familiarize themselves with that district's Student Conduct Code and all other applicable policies prior to delivering services at that facility. Rules and guidelines developed by ESD staff at a component district facility shall be consistent with and supplement Board policy and administrative regulations of the component district. The component district's policies applicable to student behavior shall take precedence of the ESD policy where inconsistent or when the issue is not addressed by ESD policy.

The superintendent shall have authority to create administrative regulations governing supervision of students. Administrative regulations shall be published in a handbook and distributed to students and/or parents/guardians upon enrollment in an ESD program or activity. The Board shall review the handbook prior to the start of each new school year.
