Public Solicitation in ESD Facilities

ESD students shall not be required to solicit their parents on behalf of any individual cause or organization not otherwise approved by the ESD or a component school district. Unless as part of an approved solicitation at a component school district site, staff will not require students to take home or require students to bring back from their parents forms or questionnaires, etc., for any organization or individual.

This policy does not prohibit the sending of notices or invitations to student homes.

It is the policy of the Board that no printed matter, announcements or personal solicitation shall be allowed in ESD offices or other facilities under its control unless the sponsor has the permission of the superintendent or designee for such activity.

The superintendent shall have authority to create administrative regulations governing this policy. A synopsis of this policy and the administrative regulations that implement it may be published in the form of an employee handbook. The Board shall review the administrative regulations and employee handbook on an annual basis.
