

Student Dress and Grooming

The following dress and grooming guidelines will be followed:

1. Dress and grooming shall be clean and in keeping with health and safety practices;
2. When a student is participating in special activities, his/her dress and grooming shall not disrupt the performance or constitute a health threat to the individual or other students;
3. Provisions for dress and grooming in special activities should arise directly out of the needs of the activity;
4. It is the desire of the Board that hair will not interfere with vision in any unsafe manner and should be kept clean and well-groomed;
5. Spandex is not allowed as regular school clothing, except in the P.E. classes. Sheer clothing is to be avoided;
6. Midsections should be adequately covered. No half shirts may be worn. Shorts must extend beyond the fingertips of the person wearing them;
7. Articles of clothing, pins, signs or other displays shall not contain language or pictures which illustrate or advertise alcohol or tobacco products, drugs, obscene or vulgar statements or implicit or explicit sexual slogans or messages. Since all drugs are illegal to students (including alcohol and tobacco) it is not consistent with the promotion of a drug-free school system to allow any of the above listed displays;
8. Students will have footwear on at all school activities and functions.
