## Elimination of Drugs and Alcohol on District Premises

Alcohol and unlawful drug use is harmful and illegal. The Board recognizes the damaging effects which can occur from the use of illegal drugs and alcohol. While the school is not responsible for substance abuse, everyone involved in the school system suffers as a result of it.

The Board realizes that alcohol and chemical dependencies are progressive, chronic and sometimes fatal diseases, which by their nature, render the victims incapable of the instinctive understanding required to seek help or medical attention. The Board believes that students harmfully involved require and deserve appropriate intervention at the earliest possible time. With early intervention, the illness is treatable.

The Board sees the role of the district as attempting to:

- 1. Maintain drug-free school environments so learning can take place;
- 2. Promote prevention through education;
- 3. Identify, intervene and support students who have substance abuse problems;
- 4. Inform students, parents and staff about intervention and referral procedures.

The district shall publish expectations and develop procedures that eliminate the use of drugs and alcohol on district premises; however, the concern for illegal drug and alcohol use extends beyond district premises.

Each year the district shall include in the student handbook clear statements of expectations and consequences should a student use illegal drugs or alcohol on district premises. Students and parents shall be informed that unlawful delivery of a controlled substance to a student or minor within 1,000 feet of district property is a Class A felony.

The district shall record incidents and report the findings to the Board in September of each year.
